This trip is managed by school staff who will manage risk and hazards according to the JPC Education Outside the Classroom (EOTC) safety management plan. This includes careful risk management forms and procedures. While risks can be maintained at acceptable levels they cannot be totally eliminated. Some risk is retained for its learning and experiential value. If you wish to come into school to see our safety management systems or have any questions, feel free to contact me.

It is important for safety reasons that students follow instructions given to them by all staff and follow all appropriate school rules. Behaviour by students that is deemed dangerous and puts themselves and/or others at undue risk will result in possible removal from the EOTC activity and their return to school.
