

**Year Thirteen Leadership Camp 2018**  
**30th, 31st -January and 1st February**

Dear Parents / Caregivers

Your Son/Daughter has indicated they are returning to John Paul College to complete Year 13 next year. To start the year the students have a year level camp, which all students are encouraged to attend.

The camp has many purposes, but the main one is to prepare the students and set the tone for what is an important and busy year. The following activities are included in the camp:

- careers advice
- JPC Student/Teacher mentoring programme
- goal setting (personal and as a group)
- team-building activities
- outdoor expedition - Tongariro Alpine Crossing

The camp is three days and two nights, these nights are based at National Park. The students will be staying at **The Park Hotel Ruapehu**. [www.the-park.co.nz](http://www.the-park.co.nz)

The main physical activities on the camp include team-building on day 2 and the main expedition of tramping the Tongariro Alpine Crossing on day 1.

The cost of the camp is \$245 per person. This includes all accommodation, food, outdoor guides and transport.

Payments of the **camp fee of \$245** can be processed through the Accounts Office by cheque, cash, eftpos and credit card.
