Enrolment Procedure

- Step one:** Apply on-line by accessing through www.jpc.school.nz/International.
Other promotional material such as the International Prospectus is helpful to read.
The JPC International App can also be downloaded for further relevant documents, including enrolment, homestay, Code of Practice, Refund policy and Orientation information.
- Step two:** The school will then review the application and make a decision. If declined the student will be immediately advised otherwise a Conditional Offer will be issued.
- Step three:** If the parents are satisfied with the costs and conditions of enrolment, the fees are paid.
A Confirmed Offer and receipt is then sent. (These docs are required for the visa.)
- Step four:** A Student Profile will also be sent and based on the information received, a suitably matched homestay will be found. A Homestay Profile of the family will then be sent to the student and parents. In addition, a Generic Health Form and EOTC Consent Form also needs to be completed and signed by the parent.
- Step four:** The student, parents or agent can then apply for a Student Visa, and book return flights.
Once the latter details are received by the school, a school approved shuttle will be arranged to pick up the student and bring them safely to their homestay family in Rotorua.
- Step five:** The student will participate in a comprehensive Orientation Programme on arrival to John Paul College. This will also involve an online Oxford Placement Test which is helpful for subject placement and might also indicate if extra tutoring is needed. Only once the student is fully prepared and ready will the student be integrated into classes.
