PURPOSE


1. To promote participation in the school co-curricular activities.
2. To provide co-curricular activities with appropriate coaching, and management structures.
3. To implement, promote and reward the principles of the fair play charter.
4. To encourage and reward all facets of co-curricular success.
5. To broaden and improve skills and competencies for all students, whether under achieving, of limited ability or those showing potential.
6. To establish strong administrative systems to facilitate effective co-curricular experiences.

GUIDELINES

- 1(a) The Sports Director has a key responsibility to oversee the administration of Sports' activities at school.
- (b) HODs or Teachers in Charge of other co-curricular areas such as Drama, Music, Kapa Haka and Pacific Island events have a key responsibility to oversee and coordinate the administration of their respective co-curricular activity.
2. These Coordinators will facilitate and encourage the formation of Co-curricular groups or teams.
3. They, along with coaches, parents and other teachers, will encourage students to participate in the groups or teams.

4. The Board of Trustees will supply funding that is received from RECT to the Sports Director and Deputy Principal Student Management who will apportion the funds to co-curricular activities.
5. All groups/teams will compete in a manner that upholds the Catholic Character of the College.
6. All students must pay, or arrange for payment, any co-curricular fees before participating in any sport or activity.
