



CRITERIA USED WHEN REVIEWING INTERNATIONAL APPLICATIONS

John Paul College reserves the right to accept or decline an enrolment.

- Must be 11-18 years old. (If under 13 years old then it is preferable to be accompanied by parent. If the student is 18 years old on the 1st January of the year of enrolment, then the student meets the maximum age requirement.)
- Full declaration of medical health
- Contactable character reference
- School reports for the previous academic year are to be provided.
- An acceptable standard of English – beyond elementary level. The school guarantees at least one time-tabled English Language class, but if it is clear that the student will struggle in mainstream classes then extra private support and tutoring is essential. This can be arranged. Should the student be at a Beginner Level of English, then he or she should attend the local Rotorua English Language Academy for fulltime Intensive English tuition before enrolling at JPC
